The children may come to the school and test on books they have read. Please call the school before you come and make sure there is someone here to let you in the computer lab.

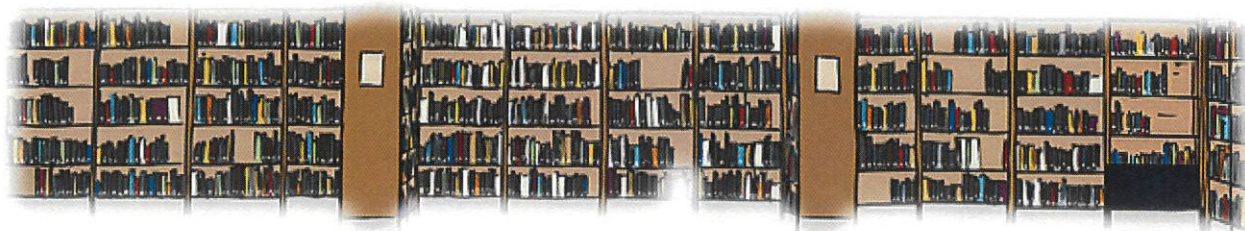
